About REIF Fukushima:

The Fukushima Renewable Energy Industry Fair (REIF Fukushima) is the biggest exhibition in renewable energy in Tohoku region in Japan.

REIF aims to provide a business matching platform for renewable energy companies from both Japan and abroad, and to realize the goal of Fukushima Prefecture to become a frontrunner in the field of renewable energy in Japan.

During the two days of the exhibition, cutting-edge technologies and products related to renewable energy and hydrogen-related industries, new energy and energy saving are exhibited and presented. Many lectures and seminars related to renewable energy and hydrogen will also be held as well as active business matching.

REIF Fukushima 2024 featured 209 exhibitors from both Japan and overseas, including Fukushima's overseas partner regions, North Rhine-Westphalia and Hamburg of Germany, the Basque Country of Spain and Denmark and attracted about 4,500 visitors.

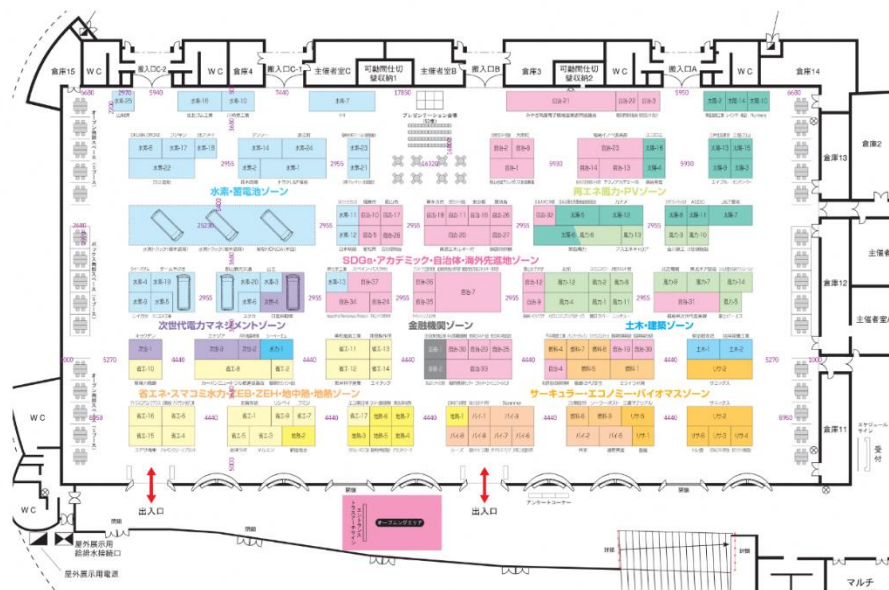

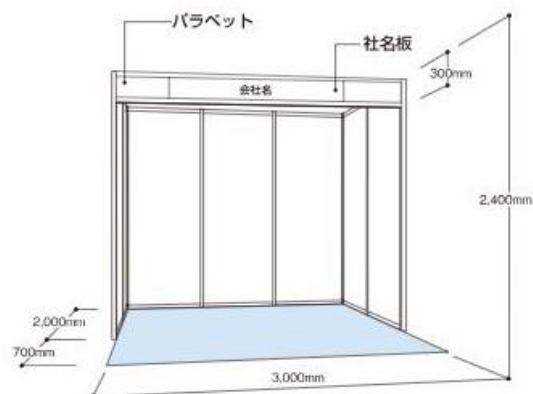

Items included in the booth fee:

Important Notices and Regulations

*In the event of natural disasters or other force majeure circumstances (including measures to prevent the spread of infectious diseases), the exhibition may be canceled or postponed. The organizer will not be liable for any damages resulting from such cancellation or postponement. However, if the decision to cancel or postpone is made prior to the event, all or part of the exhibition fee will be refunded.

*The subleasing, selling, transferring, or exchanging of all or part of your allocated exhibition space is strictly prohibited.

*The sale of goods or services involving monetary transactions (direct sales) is not permitted.

*If you plan to use open flames for exhibition or demonstration purposes, or if you intend to bring hazardous materials such as petroleum into the venue, you will be subject to restrictions in accordance with fire safety laws.

*Bringing hydrogen into the indoor multipurpose exhibition hall or using hydrogen in demonstrations is generally prohibited. However, use may be permitted under certain conditions following a fire safety review.

*If you wish to conduct hydrogen demonstrations, please provide details regarding the

demonstration area (indoor or outdoor), space requirements, and demonstration content in your exhibition application. The Secretariat will coordinate and consult with the relevant authorities approximately two months before the exhibition. Please note that depending on the nature of the demonstration, approval may not be granted by agencies such as the Fukushima Prefectural Fire Safety Division or Koriyama Fire Department.

*The organizer reserves the right to cancel the exhibition contract without prior notice if it is determined that the applicant is part of, affiliated with, or using organized crime groups or other antisocial forces.

*The organizer retains the rights to photograph, record video or audio of the exhibition and use such media. Exhibitors agree that the organizer may share personal information of exhibitors if deemed necessary for promotional purposes related to the exhibition.

*Please note that wireless devices such as Bluetooth may not function properly depending on the venue environment.
