

Important Notes

Exhibitor/Organisation Name (for joint exhibits)	<p>If two or more organisations are exhibiting jointly, the coordinating organisation should submit the application on behalf of the group and enter the names of the co-exhibiting companies/organisations in accordance with the exhibitor application form.</p>
How to Pay the Exhibition Fee	<p>We will email you an invoice once your application is complete, so please make the bank transfer by Thursday, 6 August.</p> <p>Please note that bank transfer charges must be paid by the exhibitor. The exhibition agreement will be deemed concluded once payment of the exhibition fee has been received.</p>
Stand Allocation	<p>Stand allocation will be decided by the Secretariat based on the details of your application and your business category.</p>
Cancellations	<p>In principle, cancellations are not permitted once payment of the exhibition fee has been completed. If you wish to cancel your participation, the full exhibition fee will be charged as a cancellation fee, and no refunds will be issued.</p>
Exhibiting Important Notes	<p>The exhibition may be cancelled or postponed due to natural disasters or other force majeure events (including measures to prevent the spread of infectious diseases). The organiser will not be liable for any losses arising as a result. However, if cancellation or postponement is decided before the event takes place, part or all of the exhibition fee will be refunded.</p> <p>Subletting, selling, transferring or exchanging any part or all of your exhibition space is not permitted.</p> <p>The sale of goods or provision of services involving payment (on-the-spot sales) is not permitted.</p> <p>Using naked flames for the purpose of displaying or demonstrating exhibits, or bringing hazardous materials such as petroleum into the venue, is restricted under the Fire Service Act.</p> <p>In principle, bringing hydrogen into the multi-purpose exhibition hall (indoors) and demonstrating hydrogen-powered products is prohibited. However, at the outdoor exhibition area (outdoors), permission may be granted provided certain conditions are met during the fire safety inspection.</p> <p>If you wish to do so, please submit your exhibitor application by the deadline of Friday 3 July, clearly stating the proposed location and details of the hydrogen demonstration. The Secretariat will collate the information and confirm it with the relevant authorities.</p> <p>※Please note that demonstrations of hydrogen-powered products will not be permitted unless approval is obtained from the Fukushima Prefecture Fire Safety Division, Koriyama Fire Department, etc.</p> <p>The organiser may, without prior notice, terminate the exhibition agreement if it becomes clear that the applicant is an organised crime group, an affiliated organisation or related party, or any other anti-social force, or if it is found that such forces are being utilised.</p> <p>The organiser holds the right to photograph/record and use images, video and audio from this exhibition. In addition, exhibitors and related parties are deemed to consent to the organiser providing their personal information where the organiser considers it necessary for publicity for this exhibition.</p> <p>If you use wireless devices such as Bluetooth at the venue, please be aware that they may not function depending on conditions on the day.</p>
